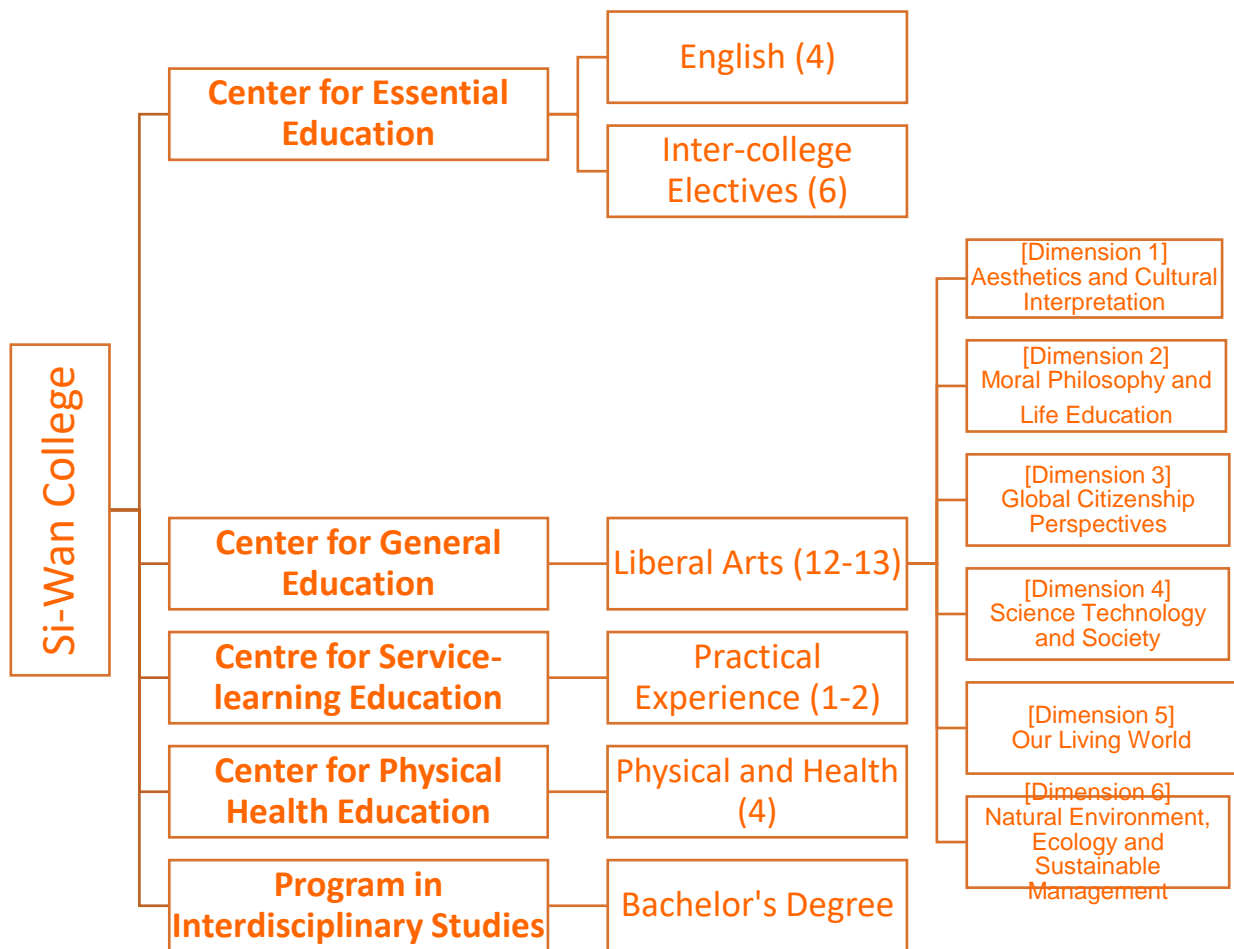


National Sun Yat-sen University General Education Curriculum

The General Education Curriculum applies to all undergraduate students who matriculated in the Fall of 2019 (108 Academic Year) or later. For those who enrolled prior to the 108 Academic Year, please contact Si-Wan College.

Numbers in parentheses indicate the minimum amount of units/credits a student needs to take in order to successfully complete the general education requirements at NSYSU.



Guidelines to Satisfy the General Education Curriculum at NSYSU

1. Students need to complete at least 31 units/credits from general education courses in order to successfully complete the general education requirement at NSYSU.
2. Language Courses: Students need to complete at least 8 credits: 4 credits from mandatory Chinese courses and 4 credits from mandatory English courses.
3. Inter-college Electives: Students need to complete at least 6 credits from courses offered by any college(s) other than the one that they are enrolled. These courses need to be recognised by Si-Wan College.
4. Liberal Arts: Students need to complete at least 3 credits from four different Dimensions: [Dimension 1] Aesthetics and Cultural Interpretation, [Dimension 2] Philosophy and Moral Thinking, [Dimension 3] Global Citizenship Perspectives, [Dimension 4] Science Technology and Society, [Dimension 5] Our Living World, and [Dimension 6] Natural Environment, Ecology and Sustainable Management.
5. Service-learning Courses: Students need to complete at least 1 credit.
6. Rules of University activities: It is compulsory to attend at least six seminars.
7. Physical Education and Health: Students need to complete at least 4 credits.
